- On Sunday at 8 o'clock I'm meeting my friend. (meet)
- They will be flying/are going to fly/ are flying to London on Friday evening. (fly)
- Wait! I will drive you to the station. (drive)
- I am seeing/am going to see my sister in April. (see)
- Look at the clouds – it is going to rain in a few minutes. (rain)
- Listen! There's someone at the door. I will open the door for you. (open)
- I am flying/am going to fly/ will be flying to Greece tomorrow. (fly)
- I'm sure Jane is not going to be a plumber (not be)
- I hope she will be there on time. (be)
- Look at her she's so pale. She is going to faint . (faint)
